Founded in 2016, Uncommon Hacks is a weekend-long celebration of technology where college students from everywhere come to Chicago to make fun, random, and innovative tech-related projects with friends old and new. Every year, we work hard to create a hackathon where all are welcome, regardless of experience or background, and where outside-the-box projects and creative thinking are encouraged. For our fifth annual hackathon last winter, we hosted more than 200 of the brightest and most highly motivated students from Universities around the United States. 2021: A VIRTUAL HACKATHON

Because of the special circumstances this year, Uncommon Hacks will be hosting our first annual hackathon from April 2-4th, where students from across the world will convene virtually to build innovative, zany, and entirely uncommon technical projects. No experience and fee required! Students at all levels of familiarity with programming, hardware, and design will have opportunities to learn new skills through workshops and contribute to team or individual projects. In 2020, 35% of our participants identified as female or non-binary, and over 40% self-reported us as their first hackathon experience. We will also host sponsors from technology companies to mentor projects and connect with students.

This year Uncommon Hacks is going cyberpunk! We'll have workshops on game building, design, and animation as well as mainstays such as intro to programming, front- and back-end web dev, and technical career skills. Hacking time will be interspersed with social events for folks to make new friends and take their minds off hacking. 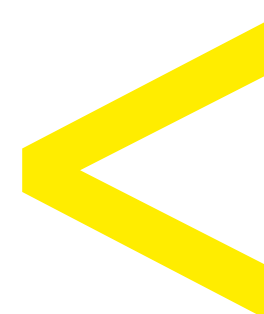
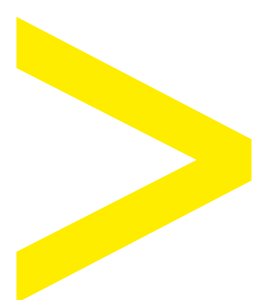
